### 2020 – CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

On August 18, 1920 the Nineteenth Amendment to the Constitution was officially ratified, enshrining Women's Right to Vote. As we approach 2020, the Idaho Women 100 Steering Committee has been planning for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of this momentous event.

The Idaho Women 100 Committee started after a conversation between Idaho Women in Leadership and the Idaho State Historical Society when they came together to discuss the historical moment of Women's Suffrage. Idaho's role in women's suffrage is unique and important because of our early 1896 state amendment allowing women the right to vote.

The Committee will celebrate and commemorate the national centennial of women's right to vote and highlight Idaho's early role regarding women's suffrage. We work to advance women's leadership and civic engagement throughout the state and preserve the historical influence of women in Idaho.

### "COURAGEOUS PAST – UNLIMITED FUTURE"

Our vision is to create a framework that will allow our partners and the public to highlight notable women in the movement throughout Idaho's past and present. We will acknowledge and recognize the influence of women in Idaho over the past 100 years and their contributions to the political, cultural, economic, academic, social, and civic fields. Our goals are to create legacy projects to live on for future generations through art, awards, collections, exhibits, and more. Through these efforts we will work to shape the future of women's leadership in Idaho by advancing shared leadership in politics, business, and education.
